RESULTS:

Due to its unsuitable condition, no testing was performed on Exhibit K4.

Exhibit K5 was not examined.

A hair suitable for STR DNA analysis was identified on K6.

K7a and K7b gave chemical indications for the presence of blood.

K2, K36, K37, K41a, K41b, K42a and K42b failed to give chemical indications for the presence of blood.

STR DNA analysis was performed on samples from the following exhibits utilizing the AmpF/STR Profiler Plus and AmpF/STR Coffler PCR Amplification Kits.

K6 Head hair from Hammond

A partial DNA profile was obtained from Exhibit K6.

K8 Buccal swabs from David Johnston

A complete DNA profile was obtained from Exhibit K8.

K7a Right fingernails from Hammond

DNA results foreign to Mary Hammond (K6) were obtained from Exhibit K7a. Due to the limited nature of these results, this data is insufficient for inclusion purposes. However, the results are consistent with originating from a male individual.

Further analysis such as Y-STR DNA testing at an accredited laboratory is suggested for Exhibit K7a.

K7b Left fingernails from Hammond

No DNA results foreign to Mary Hammond (K6) were found on Exhibit K7b.

Based on Y- quantitation results, further analysis such as Y-STR DNA testing at an accredited laboratory is suggested for Exhibit K7b.

K36 Right tennis shoe from Johnston

K37 Left tennis shoe from Johnston

K41b Plain white sock from Johnston

K42a Big sock from Johnston

No DNA results were obtained from Exhibits K36 (stains a through e), K37 (stains a, c and d), K41b (stain 1) and K42a (stains 2 and 3).

Based on DNA quantitation results, no further testing was performed on Exhibit K37 (stain b).

Due to the limited DNA results obtained from Exhibit K42a (stain 1), this data is insufficient for inclusion purposes. Results are consistent with originating from a male individual.

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REMARKS:

The DNA profile developed from Exhibit K8 has been entered into CODIS.
