Jury votes for death sentence

KISSIMMEE - An Osceola County jury on Wednesday recommended a Kissimmee man be executed for killing his 77-year-old neighbor.

Jurors voted 10 to 2 that Todd Zommer, 36, receive the death penalty, his attorney's office said.

Zommer was convicted last week of first-degree murder in the stabbing and beating of L. Corinne Robinson at her home in April 2005. In a jailhouse interview two years ago, Zommer told the Orlando Sentinel he killed Robinson because she saw him steal a boat and he feared she might report him.
