Jury Recommends Death For Crack Rage Killer



FORT LAUDERDALE (CBS4) -- Sunrise man convicted of killing three people while in a crack induced rage should die for his crimes.

That was the recommendation of a Broward jury Tuesday in the case of Ralston Davis, 24, who was found guilty earlier this month on three counts of first degree murder. In December, 2005, a drugged up Davis went to the home of Myosha Proby, 28, and shot her 26 times with an assault rifle because he believed God had told him to do it. He then went to an Exxon gas station near the Swap Shop where he shot and killed two strangers, Ravindra Basdeo, 29, and Carlos Jones, 26, at point blank range.

During the trial, Davis' attorney tried an insanity defense but the jury didn't believe it and convicted him on all three counts. Tuesday they recommended the death penalty for the murder of Proby and two life sentences without the possibility of parole for the deaths of Basdeo and Jones.

Circuit Judge Jeffrey Levenson said a Davis' sentencing date will be set during an August 28th hearing.
